Suggested Itinerary

Arrival

Airport arrival and transport to hotel. Afternoon-evening tour of Arusha. Exactly half-way between Alexandria in Egypt and Capetown in S.A. Arusha is Tanzania's second city. Made world famous for its International Criminal Court for the prosecution of Rwanda's 'genocidaires', Arusha offers the visitor a typical African town with its history in the BOMA and its lively market.

Distance: 49km/30mi

Day 1

Drive from Arusha to Tarangire National Park; game drive and lunch in the park. Leave Tarangire park for nearby Karatu at the base of Ngorongoro Crater Rim. Karatu sits on the edge of Ngorongoro Crater which you must bypass on your trip north but return on the way back.

Day 2

From Karatu entrance to park and travel to Northern Serengeti. This is a long journey with stops and potential for multiple game drives. You will see the wide plains of this magnificent park with many of Africa's 'Big Five' game. Checking into tented lodge accommodation in Northern Serengeti for well-earned, comfortable, clean rest and relaxation. This tented lodge is run by Serengeti Heritage Tented Lodge as a mobile lodge following the migration. See the Serengeti Heritage Tented Camp website for details.

Day 3

The Serengeti is famous for the twice yearly mass migration of a million-plus wildebeest followed by all their predators. As the rains end in May, the animals start moving northwest into the areas around the Grumeti River, where they typically remain until late June. The crossings of the Grumeti and Mara rivers beginning in July are a popular safari attraction because crocodiles are lying in wait. This is a great opportunity for photography and video enthusiasts as the animals charge through rivers and forests to escape the predators.

You will be staying in a mid-range tented lodge with all facilities for comfort and security.

Day 4

This leg may be customizable at the starting point of your safari. You may wish to spend an extra day on the migration route. This will depend on availability and accommodation. Meanwhile, covering the distance from Serengeti park centre to the world-famous Ngorongoro Crater you will follow and overtake the Serengeti migration route south. After your final drive through the Serengeti you will settle for one night on the crater rim of the Ngorongoro Crater before the morning game drive through the crater. With an early morning start, you will see the game at its most active - morning feeding time.

Day 5

The Ngorongoro Crater - another world heritage site offers visitors a pristine, enclosed environment for many protected species of wildlife concentrated within 250 sq. km.

Ngorongoro Crater is a must-see on any safari.

You may also see some of the Maasai tribe who historically roam between Tanzania and Kenya along the Serengeti and the Maasai Mara. They are traditionally animal herders, huntsmen and warriors. They play a vital role in animal conservation in the parks. It may be possible, if time allows, to stop in a Maasai village to witness their traditional way of life. This will be complementary to your safari. You will then travel on to your starting point in Arusha. From there we can take you back to the airport.
